HERS is an educational non-profit providing leadership and management development for women in higher education administration. Since 1972 HERS has served the higher education community, preparing more than 4300 women faculty and administrators for leadership roles.

Today HERS Alumnae are active on over 1200 campuses across the USA, South Africa, Botswana, India, Nigeria, Saudi Arabia, Micronesia, and Caribbean region. The campuses served include public and private institutions in all Carnegie categories. Currently, over 500 HERS alumnae now serve as dean, vice president, provost or president.

HERS INSTITUTES

Developing Individuals for Institutional Leadership

HERS Institutes offer an intensive 12-day curriculum of leadership and management development activities for women faculty and administrators.

HERS participants from mid-career through senior levels of responsibility strengthen skills & perspectives for immediate impact; as well as create plan & networks for continuing professional development.

Senior leaders in higher education serve as faculty for these curricular themes:

- Understanding the Environment for Higher Education
- Planning & Leading Change in the Academy
- Managing & Investing Strategic Resources
- Engaging Individual and Institutional Diversity
- Mapping Your Leadership Development.

Three HERS Institutes serve 200 women faculty and administrators annually, with 65-70 participants at each of our three partner institutions: Bryn Mawr College; University of Denver; Wellesley College.
